### DETAILS:

Dr.Sc. Drago N. Nedic, born on June, 2 1962 in Gornja Slatina, in the municipality of Samac finished elementary school in his birthplace and Grammar school in Sarajevo. He entered the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine in Sarajevo in 1982. and graduated from it in 1987. Having finished his studies, he was appointed assistant at the The Veterinary Faculty in Sarajevo, Department of Hygiene and Technology of Foods of Animal Origin where he got his master's degree, with a thesis titled "Campylobacter spp. in slaughterhouses and their importance for Food Hygiene". In August 1992, by the decision of the Government of the Republic of Srpska, he started to work for the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Water Management where he acted as a Work Group Coordinator for animal care. Following this, he was appointed Republic Veterinary Officer and soon after that a Chief Veterinary Officer of the Republic. He has been a Deputy Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Water Management since 1993. At the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine he defended his dissertation titled "Raw milk quality criterium defining in longitudinal integrated control". Since he began his work with the Ministry, he has been working on the organization of Veterinary Service of the Republic of Srpska that successfully prevents large scale outbreaks and spreading of contagious diseases of domestic animals and it also controls hygienic safety of animal originated food..

He has published more than 60 scientific and expert papers so far, 36 of which satisfying the criterium necessary for the appointment of Scientific Associate (Docent) at the Belgrade University.

As a Deputy Minister and a member of Veterinarian Society of the Republic of Srpska, he organizes consultative meetings, seminars, and expert –thematic veterinarian sessions of the Republic of Srpska.

As a Chief Veterinary Officer of the Republic of Srpska, he has been a successful representative of the Republic of Srpska in Europe (Germany, Belgium, France, Greece, Bulgaria, Holand, etc.) and the USA.

### Scientific and expert work

Dr.Sc. Drago Nedic, Deputy Minister of Agriculture of the Republic of Srpska, in the scope of his service, is especially committed to updating of the organization and functioning of veterinary service, introducing the Republic Inspection, organizing the Veterinary Institute for food safety and animals' state of health control, organizing the centre for production of semen of tested bulls, importing of quality genetic material in order to insure development of livestock breeding and provide enough foodstuffs of animal origin to satisfy the needs of the population in the Republic of Srpska.

Dr. Nedic is especially interested in the field of current epizootical-epidemiological situation in the area of the Republic of Srpska, Yugoslavia and in the world. This enables him to cooperate with O.I.E. (International Office for Contagious diseases) which implies a permanent control of diseases from A and B list and

reporting on the state of contagious diseases in the Republic of Srpska. Since Dr.Nedic became Head of Veterinary Service there has not been a single case of epizootics of contagious diseases.

Having his master's and doctor's degree, Dr. Drago Nedic satisfied the conditions for research work, thus on the proposal of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine in Belgrade he was promoted to a position of expert-associate ( Associate professor at the Faculty). Out of 36 publications considered, which were published in journals and collections from scientific meetings in the country and abroad (enclosed), 25 of them treated the problems of animal health care ( epizootical-epidemiological situation ) and foodstuffs quality and hygienic safety control. In the control of foods of animal origin, residues of veterinary medicines and additives have a very important place, as well as the contamination of raw materials and foods with heavy metals and other pollutants. The research work of Dr. Nedic shows that there is a problem of presence of residues of veterinary medicines in foods in the Republic of Srpska and that they can influence human health. The control of the residues in foods will be covered by the national program as Dr Nedic points out, by the way of including all the foods produced or imported into the Republic of Srpska .

Dr. Drago Nedic was involved in the control of snail, turtle and hedgehog meat which represented an important article in the export of former BiH and can also represent an important component in the export of the Republic of Srpska. In his scientific work, Dr. Nedic is involved in the organization of fish meat production and control, for the Republic of Srpska has a developed fishing industry and provides considerable quantities of fish meat for nutrition. Dr. Nedic is also interested in hygienically safe poultry meat.

Dr.Nedic is especially engaged in the state and possibility of improving the veterinary profession in the Republic of Srpska with the aim of personnel training and providing enough staff necessary for quality animal health care and control of reproduction of the livestock fund. Dr.Nedic treated this activity in 5 papers dealing with the organization of veterinary profession and 6 papers on the problems of health protection.

Dr. Drago Nedic is an active member of the Veterinarian Society of the Republic of Srpska where together with the other veterinarians he organizes seven annual consultative meetings of veterinarians of the Republic of Srpska, as well as a number of thematic seminars and sessions.

In his life and work so far, Dr. Drago Nedic has shown unselfish will and wish to help the veterinary profession, his people and his country. Making progress in his field, he contributed to a higher degree of specialization and thus to efficiency of the veterinary profession. During the war, he contributed greatly with his work, in terms of engaging veterinarians in war conditions on preventing outbreaks and spreading of contagious diseases. With his integrity he won the status of Veterinary service of the Republic of Srpska. not only in B&H but also internationally, thus this profession, unlike many others, has a very important place in international institutions, almost at the same level with the other countries in the world. In social work he has been chosen in a lot of organizations which contributed to the strengthening of veterinary service. It is his personal merit that not a single larger epidemic of contagious diseases has appeared recently in the area of the Republic of Srpska, neither in animals nor in humans.
